



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
MEETING THE NEEDS OF ALL OUR FAMILIES

Based on survey data, families had mixed feelings on various learning plans.

SURVEY QUESTION	UNCOMFORTABLE	NOT SURE	COMFORTABLE
How comfortable are you with the return of all staff and students to the building and engage instruction as normal?	74%	17%	9%
How comfortable are you with students and staff returning part-time in the building and part-time virtually?	41%	36%	23%
How comfortable are you with students beginning instruction fully online at home?	20%	22%	58%

Based the input from our community partners along with the parent survey data, NPFE saw a need to offer a choice to accommodate the various needs of our families.
